Leading safely is right for you and your business

The course covers:

- safety and health and what it means for different leadership roles
- the responsibilities and behaviours of a leader
- what effective health and safety leadership looks like
- what happens when things go wrong
- how leaders can make improvements
- the benefits of effective safety leadership.

Assessment

Learners use the diagnostic tool, accessed via a mobile app, to identify their current safety and health position against a set of critical questions. The tool recommends the actions they should take. At the end of the course they make a commitment to a personal action plan to improve their own and their organisations' safety and health management.
